



Family Guidelines

BE LOVING

(Matthew 22:37-39 NLT) Jesus replied, "You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. A second is equally important: *'Love your neighbor as yourself.'*

BE OBEDIENT

(Colossians 3:20 NLT) You children must always obey your parents, for this is what pleases the Lord.

(Hebrews 13:17 NLT) Obey your spiritual leaders and do what they say. Their work is to watch over your souls, and they know they are accountable to God. Give them reason to do this joyfully and not with sorrow. That would certainly not be for your benefit.

BE PATIENT

(Ephesians 4:2 NLT) Be humble and gentle. Be patient with each other, making allowance for each other's faults because of your love.

BE DILIGENT

(Ecclesiastes 9:10 NLT) Whatever you do, do well....

(2 Timothy 2:15 NLT) Work hard so God can approve you. Be a good worker, one who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly explains the word of truth.

BE SELF CONTROLLED

(Proverbs 16:32 NLT) It is better to be patient than powerful; it is better to have self-control than to conquer a city.

(Galatians 5:22-24 NLT) But when the Holy Spirit controls our lives, he will produce this kind of fruit in us: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.

BE ENCOURAGING

(Ephesians 4:29 NLT) Don't use foul or abusive language. Let everything you say be good and helpful, so that your words will be an encouragement to those who hear them.
